Dear 2013 JF Marching Band Students & Parents,

PLEASE READ THIS LETTER IN ITS ENTIRETY—WE ARE CHANGING THE WAY WE DO SOME THINGS NEXT YEAR—EVERYONE NEEDS TO BE AWARE OF SCHEDULE CHANGES, ETC.

We are in the first stages of preparation for what I hope will be the best marching season in the history of the JFHS Band. We have exciting things planned for next year—the show (titled *Who Would Ever Want To Be King?*, featuring the music of Carl Orff, Chick Corea, and Coldplay) is in development with arrangers, the drill writer, & other consultants, & I believe it will be the best show we've ever put on the field! We will compete, as usual, throughout the Mid-Atlantic region—our travel plans include an overnight trip to VA Beach & a return to the James Madison University "Parade of Champions" field competition. So far preliminary sign ups have gone well—the numbers look good—this should be an exciting season!

CHANGE: Registration will be online this year for the first time—the online form, which can be accessed on the home page of band website (www.jeffersonforestband.org), replaces the traditional registration form, volunteer form, and contact information form. Everyone will still have to fill out & submit a Medical Permission form—we have to have those in hard copy form with us all the time. The Med form & the 1st draft of the Calendar are attached to this letter. Everyone must be registered onlice by June 1—we are under contract with our drill writer to provide final numbers by June 5—only those students who have completed online registration by June 1 will be written into the show. Any after that will be considered alternates & will only be offered a spot in the show if one opens up. Medical Permission forms must be submitted in hard copy by June 1. It is essential that we have & maintain an accurate, up-to-date e-mail database of students and parents—it is by far the most effective way to disseminate information.

We ask that a parent of each marching band member attend a meeting on Thursday, May 16 at 6:00 PM in the Jefferson Forest High School band room so that we can answer any questions you may have, disseminate information, & go over band fee payment options. It is very important that you attend this meeting. We would like to collect the first installment of band fees at the meeting if possible (the actual due date is June 1). The total cost of operating the marching band is around \$800 per student—the JF Band Boosters, Inc. subsidizes approximately 50% of that amount (which covers things like staffing, show design, additional transportation, & equipment). Marching Band fees are \$400/student for 2013-14. This fee helps to offset the costs for the VA Beach trip (which includes transportation, lodging, & meals), a band t-shirt (which is part of the uniform, & property of the student), uniform & instrument use & maintenance, band camp expenses, water & soda for each performance, pizza at halftime of all home football games, & consumable marching band accessories. Band fees can be paid in 2 installments, with the 1st due by June 1 (we will be set up to collect fees at the JF Spring Concert on Tuesday, May 29) & the last due on August 1 (the 3rd day of full band camp). However, if you are able to pay the full \$400 by June 1, it would be greatly appreciated—much of the cost of operating marching band is incurred before August! For your convenience band fees may be paid online through PayPal, a secure online banking entity. PayPal accepts all major credit cards. Please note that PayPal will ask for a shipping address even if the item does not require shipping (such as band fees). This information is collected to insure that payments are applied to the appropriate

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student. A link is available from the band website (www.jeffersonforestband.org) under the "Financial" tab. Kroger Gift Card balances built up through mid-May will be applied to the June 1 installment (if you have enough to cover the entire fee or more than the initial 50% deposit, it will all be applied at that time). Any balance accrued from mid-May through mid-July will be applied to the Aug. 1 installment. My Kroger Card account has been generating around \$75/month toward my daughter's band fees—it's conceivable that you could generate enough to cover a substantial amount of the 2nd installment between mid-May & mid-July. If you don't have a Kroger Card & want to get started as soon as possible, indicate that in the appropriate place on the online registration form & someone will contact you, or submit the form attached to this letter.

Please note that the attached calendar is a 1st Draft—there will likely be some changes as we go along. There are Saturday practices scheduled during Band Camp (Aug. 3 & 10)—they replace the 2 days lost to the earlier start of the school year—I didn't want to start camp earlier.

Major change: Colorguard will have most Tuesday afternoons off and will practice without the rest of the band on Wednesdays. Brass, woodwinds, and percussion will operate under the traditional schedule, with most Wednesdays off. We will have Full Band Practice (everyone!!!) on the following Wednesdays: Sept. 4, Oct. 16, & Oct. 30. Please make an effort to schedule appointments on "off days" to minimize rehearsal absences. All rehearsals and performances are mandatory. Please see Mr. Webb if there are individual issues with specific dates. Consistent rehearsal attendance is vital to our success!

The emergency medical permission form is a blanket form that gives your child permission to participate in all band activities, including trips (see calendar), & for staff & chaperones to seek appropriate medical attention for your child if the need arises. No one will be permitted to participate in any band activity without a completed emergency medical form. This form needs to be returned by the first day of your band student's participation in marching band. In addition to the form, please submit a photocopy of the front AND back of your insurance card, & have all forms turned in by June 1. Also, we will comply with changes in BCPS policy regarding distribution on medication (prescription AND overthe-counter)—more information on that will be distributed in the fall before the first competition trip.

One of the things making Marching Band such a special & worthwhile activity is the opportunity for parent involvement. We have a large operation, & we cannot begin to succeed without the help of many parent volunteers. On the attached volunteer form, you will find a list of opportunities to get involved & be a part of this great organization. We welcome your participation in any or all of these areas. The more people we have, the less work any individual has to do, & the more fun & fulfilling it becomes for everyone. Please consider volunteering your time & talents.

I am very excited about next year's band—I believe we are going to have a fantastic fall! Please let me know if you have any questions, or if I can help you with anything regarding your child's participation in the JF Band program. abbledt

After competition season ends, Bedford Christmas Parade practices will be held on Tuesdays and/or Thursdays through December 5th.
